

PRIVACY NOTICE

IN THE CONTEXT OF CIRCULAR CULTURES DESIGN SCHOOL 2026

In the context of the project "Circular Cultures Design School 2026" ("CC Design School") we, ARIONA HELLAS S.A., a company based in Athens, at 2 Evrydamantos Str. and Galaxia, acting as a representative of the Onassis Foundation in Greece (hereinafter "ARIONA") and British Council of Athens, having its registered office in Athens (17, Filikis Eterias Sq.) ("British Council" and jointly with ARIONA referred as "we"), acting in our capacity as organizers of CC Design School and thus joint data controllers by virtue of an agreement between us, will collect the information you provide to us, as described here, –("Data"), in compliance with the relevant applicable legislation (General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (EE, Greek Law 4624/2019 and any other applicable law, as in force) and the decisions and guidelines of the competent supervisory authority.

1. What personal data do we collect?

To perform and promote the CC Design School, we collect only the information that is necessary and is identified in the relevant Terms & Conditions and the participation documents that we provide to you thereof, thus mainly identification and communication data, work material, project proposals and any information that you may share and produce in the context of participating in the CC Design School.

We note that, subject to you agreeing and granting us the relevant copyrights, during CC Design School's workshops that will take place with physical presence, there may be recording of image and/or sound of the workshops through our means or of that of designated third parties. In this context, we will process the data so that an audiovisual material from the CC Design School is created by us, which we will use to make this and CC Design School accessible to the public in the context of the promotion of our activities and actions by means of our choice, such as through our websites, social media, print, mass media or even online platforms, such as YouTube. We will archive the material produced as we do for all our actions.

We do not collect data of special categories. In exceptional and individual cases where is necessary due to the specific circumstances of your participation in the workshop's (such as information on the existence of any special needs, disabilities) we may collect such data as long as we have your consent, unless the processing of such data is performed on another legal basis such as compliance with an obligation we may have under law or where you have already made this information public.

To the extent that you provide any information or works that may identify any third party (indicatively member of your teams), we ask beforehand that the relevant participation documentation is duly filled out, signed and submitted to us by the person having the appropriate legal authorization and you undertake and warrant that you have performed all necessary actions in order to lawfully collect and transfer to us these data, including disclosure of this notice to the said natural persons.

The above information is considered necessary and in conformity with the philosophy and concept of the CC Design School which, among others, is to have a limited and varied group of participants.

2. How and why do we process your data?

We will process the Data so you can participate, and we are able to realize the CC Design School.

In this context, we will jointly process the Data in order to apply the Terms and Conditions of the CC Design School, namely in order initially to jointly assess your candidacy for your participation in CC Design School and, if your application is successful, consummate our collaboration as described in the Term and Conditions of the CC Design School.

When you submit to us your professional information about yourself, we will process such information to evaluate your application and apply the Terms of the CC Design School. Should you be selected for the CC Design School and collaborate with us, we will maintain this information in the context of our contractual relationship as we do for our collaborators.

Given the artistic nature of the CC Design School, where there is recording of sound/image we will present any produced material, upon your consent unless you have otherwise granted us any intellectual property right, to the public in the context of our activities and actions with means of our choice, such as, through our websites, social media, publications, mass media or even on line platforms such as YouTube.

In case you need to disclose to us some health conditions related to you, such as special need etc., as this may be necessary in the context of your physical participation in the CC Design School, we will request your explicit consent for doing so.

In case we do not receive all the information that is deemed necessary, we will not be able to fulfill the purposes that we describe herein and thus not be able to include your or your participation in the CC Design School.

We inform you that we will keep your contact information (email), as long as you do not declare that you disagree, in order to send you newsletters about our events and up to the submission by you of an opt-out request, which you may be able to make at any time.

3. Who has access to your information and how do we safeguard this access?

We will jointly process your information by virtue of an agreement between us (art. 26 GDPR) for the consummation of the CC Design School. The essence of this arrangement is presented herein and in the relevant Terms & Conditions of the program.

In this context, the Data will be kept and processed for the above purposes by our personnel authorized to attend to all issues regarding realization of the CC Design School and its promotion.

Additionally, for the purpose of implementing CC Design School, we may assign, under the conditions of the law, to our third-party partners (such as, but not limited to, technical solutions providers, photographers, videographers, consultants) the processing of certain necessary data (such as image or sound), who will act as "processors" and will be bound by an obligation of confidentiality and other obligations provided for in contracts and/or legal acts solely for the provision of services to us and not on their own account.

4. How long do we maintain your data?

We will collect and maintain the said data for the whole duration of the CC Design School and after that, in order to fulfill the purpose for which the Data were provided and to comply with our legal and contractual obligations and thus for as long as the relevant copyright license on any produced materials

granted is valid, taking also into account the applicable legislation's requirements, statute of limitation time periods for exercise of our legal rights and our corporate scope. More specifically,

If your application is not successful, we will delete any supporting documentation that we will have been provided with by you within 1 year from the announcement of the results for the participations so to be able to administer any vacancies, unless we have the right to maintain such record e.g. due to any other collaboration that we may have or in case you require us to. We will record your basic contact and identification information, as contained in the application form, as well as the basic information concerning the administration of the application (time of submission, subject, relevant assessment, process and progress of application), along with the reasons of rejection, and after its completion only for the time period necessary in order to fulfill our transparency obligations in relation to the selection procedures of the CC Design School participants and the exercise and defense of our legal rights against third parties, taking into account the requirements and the statutory limitation periods of the applicable legislation for the exercise of legal rights. To this effect, we will ensure that, depending on the case, appropriate measures are taken for the protection of the information that we will hold (such as encryption, pseudonymization, anonymization).

If your application is successful, we will keep the said data and those that are required from you for the fulfillment of the purpose of granting your participation under the terms to be set in a contract between us. In this case, we will maintain your Data for the whole duration of CC Design School and our contractual relationship. The data will be maintained by us after lapse of the above periods in order to fulfill the archiving and historical purposes, taking into account the requirements of the said legislation and the statutory limitation periods for the exercise of legal rights. In each case that the above purposes require that we continue to maintain data that are deemed necessary, we will ensure that we apply appropriate technical and organizational measures (such as anonymization, pseudonymization) for their protection.

5. What rights do you have?

With regard to the above-described processing we perform, you have the rights granted to you, under the specific terms and conditions of the law and in particular:

- The right to be informed and access your data that we will process,
- The right to correct or delete them, as long as we are not required to process them,
- The right to object to processing and request restriction of processing,
- The right of portability of your data to another controller or processor.
- Where processing is based on your consent, the right to revoke that consent can be exercised at any time. The withdrawal of the consent you may have given will be valid only for the future and any processing made on the basis of the consent will remain lawful until the withdrawal.

If you exercise any of these rights, we shall undertake all necessary measure to satisfy the relevant request within the time limits set by the law, by notifying you in written of the satisfaction of the request or alternatively the reasons that prevent the exercise of such rights or satisfaction of such request.
