


Keep your idea short and simple.

1. Think of something you really love. Here are some ideas to get you started:

Choose one or two of these and think about why you love it. Maybe it makes you feel happy or makes you laugh? Write down a few words or lines about it. You can make your words rhyme but you don't have to. You can repeat lines too, which is often done in songs:

Speak your words out loud a few times until you are happy with them. You will start to hear the rhythm of the words. Is your *Love Song* fast, slow or medium speed?

> 3. Now, hum a tune to go with the words. It is fun and easy to make up your own tune so give it a try!

Put your words and tune together and practice it a few times. You can also make your words into a rap or a simple chant if you prefer.

If you play an instrument, you can use it to play your Love Song too.

Remember, it needs to be short – a Love Song that is about 30 seconds long is perfect.
