## Two for C

Candoco Dance Company, the company of disabled and non-disabled dancers, is twisting perceptions of what dance is, who can dance and who enjoys it with the duet *Two for C* by award-winning choreographer Javier de Frutos.

Inspired by Tennessee Williams' play *Camino Real* and Samuel Beckett's *Waiting for Godot, Two for C* depicts a day in the life of a couple who are trapped in a stagnating relationship, characterized by struggle and power-play. Set to traditional Mexican Ranchera music by Lila Downs, the performance takes place in an intimate domestic world in which the use of Mexican wrestling masks suggests the deeper, darker forces at work. In this display of brains versus brawn, both characters go to great lengths to secure their pride and honour as they attempt to get back what is rightfully theirs
